In this class, the young artisan travels to a woodworking studio to learn the safety and use of all the basic hand and power tools. Campers learn to use tools such as the jointer, planer, miter saw, and more. The first day will be used to design a small table. After design, the student learn to cut to a cut list, glue up panels, use basic joinery methods, and assembly techniques. We end the week with wood finishing. The camper leaves with a small side table and a veritable tool chest of new skills!
