

Reading: Intensive Literacy Support

W1-W4: June 10-July 5 (four weeks)

12:30 p.m.-3:30 p.m. Entering grades 3-5.

This is a four-week long, Orton-Gillingham based literacy intervention. The program addresses the five essential components of effective reading instruction: phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension. The sessions are designed for small groups. Children will work to improve reading, and spelling skills in this half-day program. The reading and spelling curriculum is a structured, multisensory approach to phonics instruction, with an emphasis placed on learning the six syllable types and spelling rules. Daily lessons are cumulative, and there is nightly homework (20-minute minimum). \$1045 for 4 weeks. Taught by a Certified Orton-Gillingham Instructor
