In this class students learn basic wheel skills: centering, opening, pulling, shaping, trimming, finishing, and glazing. As a beginner, students make variations on the basic cylinder, such as mugs, vases, and bowls.

Experienced artists will be challenged to hone their skills with more challenging projects. This is a great chance to learn the basics of the potter's wheel in a relaxed, creative atmosphere. Artists also have a chance to explore the fundamentals of hand building with clay.
