

Supreme Court Simulation

If you've ever wondered what it would be like to argue a case before the U.S. Supreme Court--or to decide a case as a Justice--this course is for you. We'll begin with a quick introduction to the state and federal court systems, including a visit to a courthouse and/or meeting with a judge. Then you'll get a crash course in legal reasoning, through discussion of a series of cases that raise fundamental questions about how to interpret ambiguous laws. Finally, the week will culminate in a simulated oral argument in a real or hypothetical case that might be decided one day by the Supreme Court.
